

General Recess Rules

- **Students are to show respect for themselves, their fellow students and all adults. No pushing, tripping, or fighting is ever permitted.**
- **Students are to speak to fellow students and adults in a respectful manner.**
- **Students are to immediately notify an adult supervisor of an injury.**
- **Students are to immediately notify an adult supervisor of any observed dangerous or inappropriate activity such as fighting, possession of a possible weapon, drugs, etc.**
- **Students are to immediately report the presence of a stranger on the playground to an adult supervisor.**
- **Students are to be inclusive of classmates in all games and activities whenever possible.**
- **Students are to play in assigned playground areas only and are never permitted to leave the playground area without the permission of a supervising teacher.**
- **Students are responsible for returning playground equipment to appropriate containers after usage.**
- **The blowing of the whistle means STOP what you are doing and look at the teacher.**
- **Rainy days will be FLAT areas only – NO BALLS**
- **Students need to be alert when approaching and leaving the swings. Students need to swing one person in a swing at a time and are to swing straight.**
- **Students are not to climb on non-playground equipment. Benches and picnic tables are to sit and eat on.**

- Always go down the slides, no running or walking UP or handing from the slides.
- Contact sports are not permitted.
- Students need to use steps and ladders to get down from the climber-NO JUMPING.
- The throwing of rocks, ice, snowballs, dirt, mulch, etc. is not permitted. Please refrain from digging in the wood chips.
- Balls are not to be thrown or kicked against any of the buildings.
- Students are not to play near the cars.
- The ringing of the bell means it is time to line up. Students need to line up quickly, quietly, and in a straight line.
- Toys from home are not to be brought for recess.
- Students are to use the steps instead of the hill when chasing a ball.

Indoor Recess

- Students are to remain in their assigned classroom. They are not to leave the room without a supervisor's permission.
- No objects are to be thrown in the classroom.
- The homeroom teacher will provide indoor games. Students may also bring games from home on rainy days.

Appropriate Activities: Sit down games such as board games, classroom computer activities, puzzles, coloring, drawing, activity books, etc.
